Context

- All schools close as education providing institutions
- Children can work from home
- Teachers can work from home
- Wales has a nation-wide learning platform with an extensive suite of tools to support remote learning

Requirements

A policy statement setting out WG's expectations in terms of continuity of learning

Technical guidance and operational support for:

- Hardware – including pupils taking technology home
- Software and learn-ware
- Administration
- Data security
- Domestic connectivity, or alternative ways to access tools and services

Use of broadcast for delivery of learning materials

Understanding of content / communication / collaboration tools in the system, and how they are used for teacher-pupil, teacher-parent and teacher-teacher working

Guidance to teachers and heads on:

- Options for learning
- Learning design
- Online pedagogy
- Sharing resources
- Using the whole Hwb toolset
- Tracking and recording progress

Guidance to parents on supporting learning at home

Possibly buying in common content for the whole system

- Effective working from home
- Ensuring productivity
- Meetings
- Governance
