

“The £20 a week uplift to the Universal Credit standard allowance **[DN: insert equivalent wording for tax credits]** is intended to target financial support on those experiencing the most financial disruption as a result of the current pandemic.”

Are we sure this group is the most financially disrupted (as opposed to other people who have lost their jobs and claiming ESA/JSA/IS etc.)? Or does the answer mean that claimants to new style may have some savings to fall back on?

I'm not sure I have any analysis to support an uplifting decision based on this criteria(although it may be there). If we answer in these terms I think it begs further questions e.g. how did we come to define in this way, will we publish our analysis etc and so puts us on the back foot.

We have announced measures that can be quickly and effectively operationalised. This allowed, for example, for the swift introduction of the £20 a week uplift to the Universal Credit standard allowance to respond to the effects of the current pandemic for those experiencing the most financial disruption.

The changes we have already made to legacy benefits assist those claimants in response to the pandemic and the existing package of support is fair.

Moreover, the Universal Credit IT system is more flexible than those used to deliver Jobseeker's Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance and Income Support. It also uses different technology from other DWP systems, including those making State Pension payments. These older systems have complex interactions and interdependencies.

We consider that there is an unacceptable level of risk to existing payments of the benefits delivered on those systems if we sought to use the annual up-rating mechanism for a second time in one tax year. Our priority is safeguarding the safety and stability of the benefits system overall.

The following special points should be noted:

- On Friday 20 March, the Chancellor announced a temporary increase to the Universal Credit standard allowance and the Working Tax Credit (WTC) basic element on top of the planned annual uprating.
- The standard rate in Universal Credit has been temporarily increased for the 20/21 tax year by £86.67 per month (equivalent to £20 per week) on top of the planned annual uprating. This additional increase means claimants will be up to £1,040 better off.
- We estimate that 2.5m households on UC and 1.6m households on WTC will benefit straight away from the temporary increase of the UC standard allowance and WTC basic element, as well as new claimants who become unemployed or whose earnings or work hours decrease because of the outbreak.
